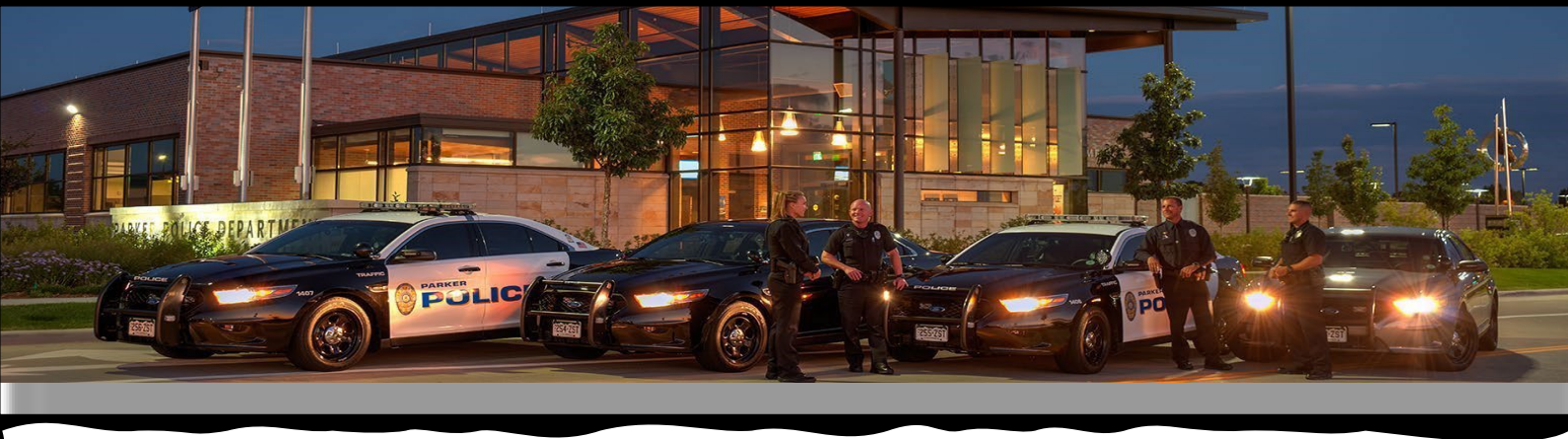


COPPS Newsletter

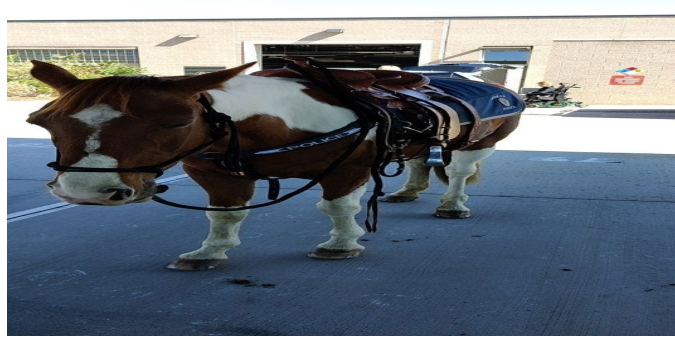

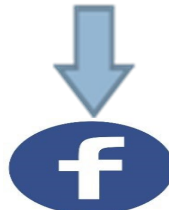
